

## **Action Required for Affected Voters**

The Greenlee County Recorder has identified voters potentially impacted by this MVD coding error and has sent notices to all voters affected.

Did you received a notification from the Greenlee County Recorder?





If you received a notification, it means you are among those voters potentially affected by the MVD coding error. The notification will contain instructions on how to submit the required documentary proof of citizenship.

It is essential that you follow these instructions and provide the requested documentation as soon as possible.

## **Acceptable Documentation**

Acceptable forms of documentary proof of citizenship include:

- A legible copy of birth certificate
- A legible copy of valid U.S. Passport
- A legible copy of Certificate of Naturalization or certificate #
- Bureau of Indian Affairs, Tribal Treaty, or Tribal Enrollment card #

The notification from the Greenlee County Recorder included a return envelope to mail copies to our office. **Do not send original documents.** 

## **Summary**

Due to a MVD coding error, some Arizona voters who registered to vote at the MVD were incorrectly coded as having provided proof of citizenship. If you received a notification from the Greenlee County Recorder, it is crucial to submit acceptable documentation of citizenship as soon as possible to remain eligible to vote in the next election.
