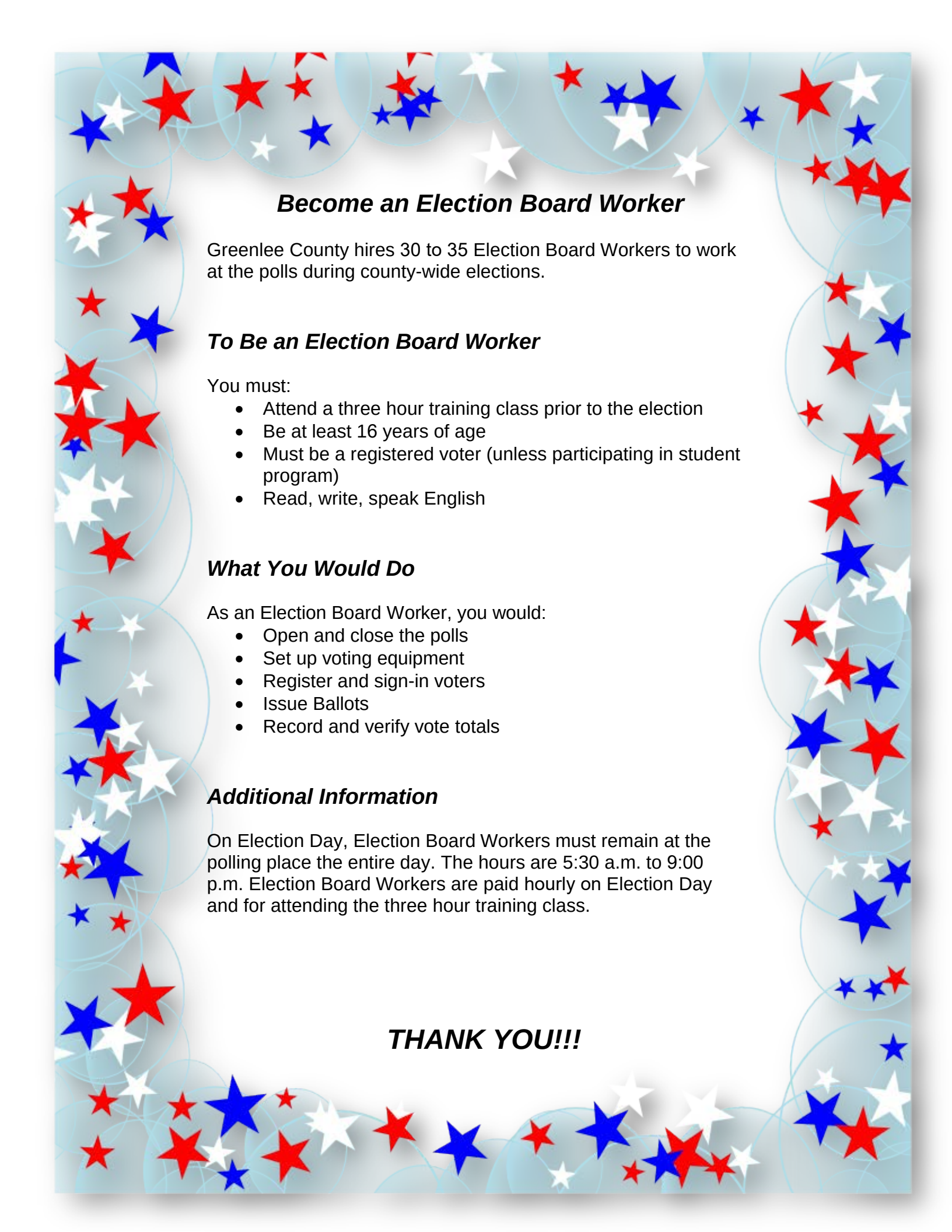




Become an Election Board Worker

Greenlee County hires 30 to 35 Election Board Workers to work at the polls during county-wide elections.

To Be an Election Board Worker

You must:

- Attend a three hour training class prior to the election
- Be at least 16 years of age
- Must be a registered voter (unless participating in student program)
- Read, write, speak English

What You Would Do

As an Election Board Worker, you would:

- Open and close the polls
- Set up voting equipment
- Register and sign-in voters
- Issue Ballots
- Record and verify vote totals

Additional Information

On Election Day, Election Board Workers must remain at the polling place the entire day. The hours are 5:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Election Board Workers are paid hourly on Election Day and for attending the three hour training class.
