Who is qualified to be a Board Worker?

- Must be at least 16 years old
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must attend required training
- Must be a registered voter (unless participating in student program)

What does an Election Board Worker do?

- Assisting in setting up and taking down the polling place
- Providing direct help to voters as necessary
- Knowing how to properly use the voting equipment
- Checking voter identification
- Issuing voters the proper ballot
- Serving all voters promptly and with specific sensitivity to voters with special needs
